Romans 10:14 Prayer Campaign: There are still 68.5 million people displaced from their homes; 23.1 million are recognised as refugees or asylum seekers. Many of these refugees in Europe have come from nations where Christ is not widely proclaimed. Serving in Mission has partnered with nine other Christian organisations to produce the #Howwilltheyhear campaign. The vision is to see the Good News proclaimed to all refugee communities in Europe and the Middle East, and to commit the faithful gospel work of Christian missionaries, churches and aid organisations to our Lord in prayer. As part of this campaign, SiM and partners have launched the 10:14 prayer initiative. This is 14 days of prayer, 10 minutes a day for 14 days starting on the 14th October. Please do join us in praying for refugees and migrants to come to a living faith in Jesus.

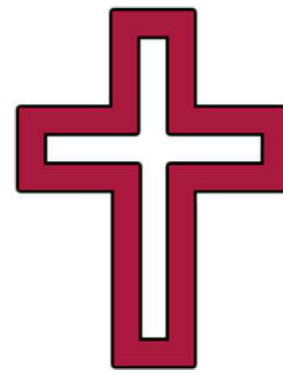
