



Pastoral Update 18.02.2021

Dear friends,

Welcome to this week's pastoral update. Please use the update not only for information but also for prayer.

1. Online Service this Sunday

This Sunday's service will be led by Hannah Childs and Gideon Fairhall, in a 'Zoom into Church' takeover. They will do this live, with other pre-recorded elements slotted in. This is the first time we'll have attempted a service led live on Sunday morning. Matthew and Sarah Newman are leading sung worship, there will be a Hannah and Gideon 'challenge' as part of the service, the Bible reading will take the form of a story told by children from across the church, and, all being well, Chris Makufa will be leading prayers (from Swaziland). Mark Roques will be preaching from 1 Samuel 17 and the story of David and Goliath. I've been personally challenged and encouraged by Mark's ministry over the past eight months, both online and in person at a service at Cragg last year. I'm really looking forward to hearing him again, and finding out what God wants to say through him.

Please note these details are correct as to the live stream. For the pre-recorded version for the DVDs Hannah will record the links on her own.

Please do plan to engage with the service, on Sunday morning if you can. And please pray both for Hannah and Gideon and also the 'back office' team of Nathan and Adrian Howe, together with Tim Hobbs who continues to edit the services together.
